

Mushball

Mushball softball is a variation of softball that uses a larger, softer 16-inch ball and often plays without gloves or mitts. It's similar to slow-pitch softball but with a 50-foot base path. The game is designed to be more recreational and less competitive than standard softball.

General Rules:

- **Pitching:** The pitch must be underhand with no spins and at an average speed.
- **Strike zone:** Strikes are typically called based on the ball crossing the plate, being within a foot left or right of the plate, or a foot behind the plate within the specified height.
- **Foul balls:** Fouls are typically determined by where the ball lands and how it bounces.
